ABOUT

The City of Adelaide Prize is a state prize category within the prestigious South Australian Architecture Awards Program, which is part of the National Architecture Awards program. The Prize is presented by the Institute on behalf of the City of Adelaide.

The City of Adelaide the Australian Institute of Architects are working together to support the enhancement of the public experience of Adelaide.

The Prize recognises and awards innovative built projects including public art and temporary contributions to public space that activate and enliven the City's public spaces and engage with the community.

AIMS

In presenting the Prize, the Council aims to:

- provide leadership in the design of the public realm;
- highlight the role of design in the creation of successful public places; and
- promote good design to the broader community.

TO ENTER

Entry is free for the highly acclaimed City of Adelaide Prize, an exciting opportunity to promote your project and organisation in the local community, architecture and design sector, and in the media, including print, online, radio and social media.

The winners of the City of Adelaide Prize are announced at the annual South Australian Architecture Awards Presentation Dinner by the Lord Mayor of Adelaide with over 400 guests in attendance. During the awards ceremony, winners will receive a beautiful glass trophy designed by Jam Factory Contemporary Craft & Design and a framed certificate signed by the Lord Mayor of Adelaide and Chapter President of the Australian Institute of Architects.

The community is invited annually to vote for their favourite project for the City of Adelaide Prize People's Choice Award.

Projects must display innovation and excellence in enhancing the public realm of the City and include:

- buildings
- landscape works
- public art installations
- performance spaces
- any other built projects that enhance public experience.

Projects must be located within the City of Adelaide and have been completed in the past two years. Individual stages or components of projects are also eligible for entry. Projects undertaken by or for the Adelaide City Council, State Government and/or Federal Government are also eligible.

Nominations not awarded The City of Adelaide Prize in the year it is entered are able to be submitted for up to two consecutive years after substantial completion. Whilst nominations may be submitted by any person or group, the client and the principle designer/consultant must agree in writing to the nomination being submitted.

KEY DATES

Entry into the Prize will take place in accordance with the SA Architecture Awards Program structure, as outlined below:

Step 1: Online entries Open - Mon 3 Dec 2018

Step 2: Presentation Delivered - Fri 1 Mar 2019

Step 3: Presentation of entry to jury - Sat 16 Mar 2019

Step 4: Site visits by jury - April

Step 5: Award presentation dinner - Sat 29 Jun 2019
